Summary and Overall Rating

Amelia Earhart Elementary is a long-established public school located in Hialeah, Florida, serving students from PreK to grade 5. The school has demonstrated recent academic improvement and provides a stable day-to-day environment. However, as part of the Miami Dade County Public Schools system, it is required to follow district policies that promote gender identity affirmation and LGBTQ inclusion at all grade levels, including elementary.

From a traditional or faith-based family perspective, Amelia Earhart Elementary rates a **3.5 out of 10** in terms of alignment with conservative educational values. The school is moderate in practice but operates under a district framework that many parents may find incompatible with their beliefs about education, family, and age-appropriate content.

1. General Overview

Amelia Earhart Elementary opened in 1963 and currently serves approximately 456 students with a staff of around 28 to 29 full time teachers. The school maintains a student-to-teacher ratio of about 16 to 1. It operates on a 10.6 acre campus and is part of the fourth-largest public school district in the United States.

2. Academic Standing

The school earned a B grade in the 2022 to 2023 academic year and improved to an A in 2023 to 2024. Approximately 52 percent of students are proficient in both math and reading based on state testing. The school offers a gifted and talented program and ranks in the top 50 percent of public schools statewide. While solid, it is not considered among Florida's highest-performing academic institutions.

3. Student Demographics

The school serves a diverse and primarily Hispanic population. About 49 percent of students identify as Hispanic and approximately 7 percent as Black, with the remainder made up of

White, Asian, and multiracial students. Around 69 percent of students qualify for free or reduced lunch, placing the school in the Title I category. Amelia Earhart serves a lower to middle income community and receives equity-focused support from the district.

4. Facilities

The campus includes a main school building, an annex, six portable classrooms, and a school library. It also offers outdoor spaces for recreation and learning.

5. Values and Cultural Environment

5.1 District Policies on Gender and Sexual Orientation

Miami Dade County Public Schools enforces a comprehensive inclusion policy that covers sexual orientation and gender identity. Teachers and staff are expected to use students' preferred names and pronouns regardless of age, and in some cases, parents may not be notified of a child's expressed identity at school.

The district promotes the SAFE Network, a systemwide initiative designed to create affirming environments for LGBTQ students. All schools, including elementary campuses like Amelia Earhart, are required to participate. While promoted as inclusive and protective, these policies raise concerns among traditional families about age appropriateness and parental rights.

5.2 School-Level Practice

There are no known controversies or incidents related to LGBTQ activism at Amelia Earhart Elementary. However, the school follows all district mandates, meaning inclusive training has been implemented and policies are likely practiced school-wide. Parents with concerns should consider speaking directly with school administrators to better understand how these guidelines are applied in early grade classrooms.

6. School Board and Political Climate

In September 2022, the Miami Dade School Board voted 8 to 1 against formally recognizing LGBTQ History Month or incorporating LGBTQ civil rights cases into high school social studies lessons. While this decision applied to upper grades, it reflected concerns tied to Florida's Parental Rights in Education law.

Still, elementary schools like Amelia Earhart continue to follow inclusive practices due to broader district policy. This reveals a growing tension between state mandates and local enforcement. For conservative families, the school board's vote may signal some political resistance, but classroom-level policies remain unchanged.

7. Parent Concerns

Parents who value traditional beliefs may find the following points concerning:

- Early introduction of gender identity and LGBTQ topics, even at the PreK or kindergarten level
- Limited parental control or awareness of how a child's identity is managed at school
- A shift in focus from core academic subjects to social identity frameworks

While Amelia Earhart Elementary is not involved in activism, its adherence to district policies means that these matters may still affect the school environment.

8. Conclusion

Amelia Earhart Elementary is a stable, academically improving public school with a diverse student body and dedicated staff. It offers strong academic support and a safe physical environment. However, families who prioritize traditional or religious values should be aware that the school is embedded in a district that actively promotes gender inclusion policies beginning at the elementary level.

Parents are encouraged to engage with school leadership, review classroom practices, and consider whether the policy environment aligns with their family's values.

Conservatism Alignment Rating: 3.5 out of 10

This rating reflects the school's position on a scale from 1 to 10, where 1 indicates full alignment with progressive gender and inclusion policies and 10 reflects strong support for traditional, conservative educational values.

Rating Breakdown:

1. Policy Environment: 2 out of 10

The district enforces progressive inclusion policies that promote LGBTQ affirming spaces in every school, including elementary campuses. Teachers are expected to affirm gender identity even without informing parents.

2. School-Level Practice: 5 out of 10

The school itself has not shown signs of activism. There have been no public controversies, but it remains fully compliant with district policies.

3. Classroom Exposure: 4 out of 10

There is no formal LGBTQ curriculum at the elementary level, but students may be exposed to identity-based discussions or visual content through signage, staff training, or informal settings.

4. Community and Cultural Tone: 6 out of 10

Amelia Earhart Elementary serves a working-class, culturally traditional community. The day-to-

day atmosphere appears calm and respectful, but broader district influence still shapes classroom expectations.

Final Summary for Parents

If your family places a high priority on traditional values and seeks to avoid early exposure to social ideology in education, Amelia Earhart Elementary may raise concerns. The school itself maintains a disciplined environment, but it operates within a system that emphasizes early identity affirmation and inclusivity. While some families may find the environment acceptable, others may prefer to explore alternative schools or educational approaches that better match their worldview.
