Summary and Overall Rating

Biscayne Beach Elementary is a public Title I school in Miami Beach, serving students from PreK through grade 5. The school offers strong academic and enrichment programs, including Gifted and Talented and International Baccalaureate. Its favorable test scores and attentive learning environment stand out. However, the school operates under Miami Dade County Public Schools, which enforces gender identity affirmation and LGBTQ inclusive policies beginning in early grades.

From a traditional or faith-based perspective, the school receives a **3.5 out of 10** rating for alignment with conservative educational values. The campus exudes academic excellence and calm, yet district-wide mandates strongly shape its approach to identity and inclusion.

1. General Overview

Biscayne Beach Elementary enrolls around 530 to 630 students and employs approximately 42 to 47 teachers, yielding a student-to-teacher ratio near 15 to 17 to 1. The campus includes standard classrooms, a library, and outdoor recreation areas, and offers before- and after-school care.

2. Academic Standing

The school earns solid academic marks, holding a B grade on state assessments and a 7 out of 10 rating from educational review platforms. State testing shows roughly 72 percent proficiency in reading and above-average performance in math. It is among the top schools in the district and state for academic achievement.

3. Student Demographics

The student body is about 83 to 85 percent Hispanic, with roughly 10 percent White and minor representation of Black and Asian students. Around 58 to 63 percent of students qualify for free or reduced-price lunch, qualifying the school for Title I support. The population is diverse and economically mixed.

4. Facilities and Programs

Biscayne Beach Elementary offers a full range of facilities including a media center and playground. The school delivers Gifted and Talented programming, International Baccalaureate curriculum, arts, STEM activities, and after-school options. It provides a well-rounded academic environment.

5. Values and Cultural Environment

District Policies on Gender Identity and LGBTQ Inclusion

Miami Dade County Public Schools includes gender identity and sexual orientation under its anti-discrimination and anti-bullying policies. Staff are expected to honor students' chosen names and pronouns. The district's SAFE Network fosters LGBTQ inclusive environments in all schools. From a traditional standpoint, these policies may introduce sensitive issues earlier than some families prefer and raise concerns about parental rights.

School-Level Practice

Biscayne Beach Elementary has no known controversy related to LGBTQ matters. School leadership and staff comply fully with district mandates. Parents concerned about identity-related practices in classrooms may wish to engage with administrators to understand how these policies apply locally.

6. School Board and Political Climate

In 2022, the Miami Dade School Board voted against recognizing LGBTQ History Month in high schools and opposed including LGBTQ civil rights content in senior-level social studies. Elementary schools like Biscayne Beach remain subject to district inclusivity policies. This marks a tension between statewide conservative measures and local district practices.

7. Parent Concerns

Traditional families may raise the following concerns:

- Exposure to gender identity themes at an early age
- Privacy rules that may enable identity expression without parental awareness
- Shift in focus from core academics to identity-based topics

Although Biscayne Beach Elementary exhibits no activism, its adherence to district-wide inclusive policies may not align with conservative values.

8. Conclusion

Biscayne Beach Elementary offers strong academics, enrichment programs, and a calm, attentive learning atmosphere. It serves a diverse student body effectively and maintains one of the stronger academic records in the district.

However, families valuing traditional approaches should consider that the school operates under district mandates affirming early LGBTQ inclusion. The campus remains well-structured, but its policy environment reflects broader progressive values.

Parents are advised to connect with school leadership, ask for policy details, and assess whether the school aligns with their beliefs.
