Summary and Overall Rating

Charles D. Wyche, Jr. Elementary School is a Title I public school in Miami Gardens serving PreK through grade 5, with approximately 502 students and a student-to-teacher ratio of about 16 to 1. The school is rated average academically, featuring Gifted and Talented offerings and stability in learning. It operates under Miami-Dade County Public Schools, which enforces gender identity affirmation and LGBTQ inclusion from early grades onward.

From a traditional or faith-based vantage point, the school scores **3.5 out of 10** for alignment with conservative educational values. It maintains a calm, supportive culture with positive parent reviews, but district policies and the absence of personal oversight standards may not align with more traditional expectations.

1. General Overview

The school serves around 502 students in the Miami Gardens area. It offers preschool, core elementary grades, Gifted and Talented programs, and after-school care. Enrollment trends and staff stability contribute to continuity in educational delivery.

2. Academic Standing

GreatSchools assigns a 5 out of 10 rating, while state test proficiency is approximately 41% in math and 44% in reading. Another educational review platform gives an overall B-minus grade. The school's performance is average compared to other public schools in Florida.

3. Student Demographics

The student population is overwhelmingly Hispanic (87.5%) and includes a significant Black minority (9.3%), with smaller percentages of Asian and multiracial students. Around 71% of students are eligible for free or reduced-price lunch, reflecting a high-need community.

4. Facilities and Programs

The school offers standard amenities — classrooms, media center, playground — and programs including preschool, Gifted & Talented, ESOL support, and special education. Staff include reading and math coaches, counselors, and community liaisons.

5. Values and Cultural Environment

District Policies on Gender Identity and LGBTQ Inclusion

Miami-Dade County Public Schools includes gender identity and sexual orientation under anti-discrimination and anti-bullying policies. Teachers and staff are required to use students' preferred names and pronouns from early grades. The SAFE Network provides district-wide training to create LGBTQ-affirming environments. Traditional families may find these policies introduce complex identity topics before parental oversight is involved.

School-Level Practice

No specific LGBTQ controversies or activism have been reported at the school. It appears compliant with district training and identity policies. Parents seeking clarity on how these values are implemented in classrooms are encouraged to connect with administrators.

6. Recent Negative Incidents or Controversies

No public records, news items, or parent complaints related to safety, misconduct, LGBTQ issues, or disciplinary problems were found for Charles D. Wyche, Jr. Elementary School. The school appears to have a controversy-free record.

7. School Board and Political Context

In 2022, the Miami-Dade School Board voted against recognizing LGBTQ History Month and integrating LGBTQ civil rights content in high schools. However, elementary schools continue to follow district-wide inclusive policies. This reflects a broader tension between state-level conservative pressures and local district practices.

8. Parent Concerns

Parents with traditional views may have concerns such as:

- Early exposure to gender identity and pronoun use without requiring parental input
- District policies that could shift focus from academics to social issues
- Lack of clear, formal guidance on how identity preference decisions are communicated to families

9. Conclusion

Charles D. Wyche, Jr. Elementary offers average academic outcomes, Gifted programs, and a stable school community. It is guided by district policies affirming gender identity, which may not align with traditional value systems. The absence of controversies suggests reliable day-to-day management, but parents should inquire about how identity and pronoun practices are handled.

Final Summary for Parents

Charles D. Wyche, Jr. Elementary provides a steady academic environment and enrichment programs. However, it operates within a district that emphasizes early identity affirmation and LGBTQ inclusion. With no notable controversies, it appears well-managed, though the policy framework may not match conservative family priorities. Families may benefit from meeting with school leadership, reviewing policy application, and confirming alignment with their family's values before enrollment.
