### **Summary and Overall Rating**

Dante B. Fascell Elementary serves students from PreK through fifth grade in Palmetto Bay and consistently ranks among the top elementary schools in Miami. Proficiency rates are strong at approximately 85 percent in math and 82 percent in reading. The school offers a Gifted and Talented program, STEAM integration, and a robust range of extracurricular activities.

The school operates under district policies requiring respect for student pronouns and LGBTQ inclusion from the earliest grades without parental opt-out. From a traditional or faith-based perspective the school receives a **rating of 3.5 out of 10**, balancing strong academic offerings with concerns about district identity protocols and cultural expectations.

### **1. Academic Standing & Programs**

Dante B. Fascell Elementary is known for maintaining excellent academic outcomes. It includes:

- Math proficiency around 85 percent and reading proficiency near 82 percent
- A minus rating from the state and a top 10 rating on public review platforms

- Gifted and Talented classes, full STEAM curriculum, music, arts, robotics, and school newspaper club
- Athletic programs and participation in science fairs spelling bees and cultural showcases

These opportunities support strong student engagement and academic growth.

## **2. Student Community & Support Services**

The school serves approximately 835 students with a student teacher ratio of about 17 to 1. The student population is predominantly Hispanic with a sizable White community presence. About 11 percent of students receive financial assistance. Services include ESL support special education counseling and academic coaches.

## **3. Facilities & Learning Environment**

Campus amenities include standard classrooms a library a multimedia center STEAM lab outdoor learning spaces and a garden. The school partners with community organizations for before and aftercare programs. Regular safety drills and climate assessments are used to maintain a supportive environment.

## **4. Values & Policy Environment**

District policy mandates staff respect for preferred pronouns and LGBTQ inclusion training through SAFE Network programs. Though no formal LGBTQ curriculum is promoted at the elementary level inclusive language may appear in guidance lessons or staff interactions.

Parents may wish to meet with teachers and counselors to clarify how these protocols are handled and ensure alignment with home values.

## **5. Parent Engagement & Communication**

Dante B. Fascell promotes active parent involvement through:

- Monthly advisory council and PTA meetings
- Parent Academy workshops on reading math safety and online resources
- Volunteer opportunities and classroom journeys
- Frequent newsletters and updates via social media and the school website

These channels help families stay informed and engaged.

## **6. Recent Issues or Challenges**

No recent student safety controversies were identified. The school has maintained a high reputation for organization and responsiveness. Emergency management plans are updated annually and parent alerts are sent promptly when issues arise.

## 7. Parent Concerns & Suggested Actions

Families with traditional or religious values may wish to explore:

- How and when pronoun preferences are acknowledged in classrooms
- Academic workload and expectations especially for gifted and advanced learners
- Communication protocol when safety or behavior incidents occur
- Opportunities to influence school culture through advisory councils and parent involvement

### Helpful parenting steps include:

- 1 Attend advisory council sessions to learn school approach and priorities
- 2 Meet with teachers early in the year to set expectations for communication
- 3 Volunteer in events or classrooms to experience day-to-day culture
- 4 Review the family handbook and emergency policies together as a household
