Summary and Overall Rating

David Fairchild Elementary is a public Title One school in Miami serving students from PreK through 5th grade. The school consistently earns top performance marks including an A-minus grade. Student proficiency rates are typically between seventy-five and seventy-nine percent in math and seventy-eight to seventy-nine percent in reading.

The school operates under district policies requiring staff to respect student-chosen names and pronouns regardless of parental consent. From a traditional or faith perspective the school receives a **rating of three point five out of ten**. While the academic excellence and learning environment are impressive some families may wish to review policy practices before enrolling.

1. Academic Standing and Programs

David Fairchild is among the top performing schools in the state with solid proficiency rates in math and reading. It features Gifted and Talented instruction STEAM integration arts and music enrichment and clubs such as student council media production botany and spelling bee. The school prioritizes achievement and well rounded education for all students.

2. Student Community and Support Services

Serving approximately four hundred and seventy eight students the student teacher ratio is about sixteen to one. The student body is diverse with seventy five percent Hispanic nineteen percent White and small percentages of Black and other backgrounds. Twenty three percent of students qualify for free or reduced price lunch. The school offers ESL special education support school counseling mental health services and dedicated staff for reading intervention.

3. Facilities and Learning Environment

Facilities include modern classrooms a library media center STEAM lab and outdoor learning areas. After school programs are available through a YMCA partnership. The school implements student safety procedures for drop off and pick up closed campus protocols and supervised recess. Homework policies vary by grade and typically involve twenty to thirty minutes daily with mandatory reading.

4. Values and Policy Environment

Miami Dade district policy classifies gender identity and sexual orientation as protected categories and requires staff to use student preferred names and pronouns starting in elementary school. While the school does not promote activism or identity focused events inclusive language may appear in schools processes or counseling sessions.

Parents may wish to schedule a meeting with school administration to understand how these policies are implemented on a day to day basis and whether family preferences are honored.

5. Recent Issues or Concerns

No recent controversies have been reported. The school uses formal emergency protocols threat assessment guidelines and conducts regular drills. Parents are encouraged to inquire about how the school handles serious incidents communication workflows and notification procedures.

6. Parent Engagement and Communication

The school encourages parent involvement through monthly advisory council meetings Parent Academy workshops volunteer opportunities and regular updates via newsletters social media and the school website. Parents are invited to be part of classrooms events and planning activities.

Helpful tip Attend a council meeting early in the year to learn about local priorities and program goals.

7. Parent Concerns and Recommended Actions

Families with traditional or faith-based values may consider the following:

- How staff training and district policies on pronouns are executed in classrooms
- Whether academic pacing and homework load are age appropriate
- How the school communicates behavior or safety incidents to parents
- Opportunities to influence policy via advisory council or PTA involvement

Helpful actions include scheduling a meeting with administrators reviewing the school handbook attending volunteer orientation and observing classrooms or school events.
