Eneida Massas Hartner Elementary is a public PreK to Grade 5 school located in Miami. It serves approximately 311 students with a student to teacher ratio of 15 to 1. The school is part of Miami Dade County Public Schools. It has shown steady efforts in academic support and community involvement but struggles with below average reading scores and high chronic absenteeism. Based on values important to many traditional or faith-based families, the school receives a **rating of 3.5 out of 10**.

1. Academic Standing and Programs

The school has a B minus grade overall. Around 52 percent of students are proficient in math while only 32 percent meet reading standards. A gifted and talented program is available along with support services for struggling students. While these efforts are valuable, academic performance remains behind many other public schools in Florida.

2. Student Community and Support Services

The student population is predominantly Hispanic at approximately 82 percent and about 15 percent are Black. Around 62 percent of students qualify for free or reduced lunch. The school qualifies for Title I support and offers ESL instruction, special education, and academic coaching. There is a focus on addressing learning gaps through targeted programs.

3. Facilities and Learning Environment

The school features standard classrooms, a media center, and outdoor play areas. It holds family events such as science nights and literacy activities. The campus is clean and safe, and students generally report feeling supported by their teachers and counselors.

4. Values and Policy Environment

The school follows district policies requiring teachers and staff to respect student gender identity and pronoun preferences starting in early grades. No formal LGBTQ curriculum is taught at the elementary level, but inclusive language and content may be introduced informally. Staff receive professional development in these areas.

For parents with concerns about age-appropriate content, it is advisable to ask how district policies are implemented in specific classrooms.

5. Recent Incidents or Concerns

There are no recent high-profile incidents of violence or misconduct. However, parents have voiced concerns about classroom behavior management and inconsistent communication about student issues. Chronic absenteeism is also high, affecting nearly one-third of students.

6. Parent Engagement and Communication

The school offers multiple opportunities for family involvement including Parent Academy workshops, advisory council meetings, and classroom volunteer programs. Some parents appreciate the effort to connect home and school. Others note delays in response time when concerns arise.

7. Parent Concerns and Suggested Actions

Families with traditional or religious values may wish to consider the following:

- How gender identity and pronoun policies are practiced in classrooms
- The school's performance in reading and long-term academic outcomes
- The impact of high absenteeism on instruction and peer interaction
- Communication procedures and staff responsiveness to family concerns

Suggested actions for parents:

- Visit the school in person and speak with the principal about policy implementation
- Attend parent meetings to stay informed and build relationships with staff
- Monitor attendance and request academic support when needed
- Clarify how your child's personal values and privacy will be respected

Eneida Massas Hartner Elementary is a caring school with helpful staff and strong community outreach. However, academic achievement remains low and absenteeism is a serious challenge. For families concerned about early exposure to sensitive topics or looking for a more traditional environment, this school may not fully align with those expectations. A school visit and conversation with leadership is highly recommended to make an informed decision that reflects your family's values and your child's needs.
