---

**Palmetto Elementary School** serves students from PreK through Fifth Grade in Pinecrest. It enrolls approximately 900 students and maintains a student teacher ratio of around seventeen to one. Academic performance is among the highest in the district with approximately 85 percent proficiency in math and 80 percent in reading. From a traditional or faith based perspective the school receives a rating of 8 out of 10, reflecting high academic achievement and stable operations with minimal policy concerns.

#### **1. Student Demographics and Support Services**

- The student population is approximately 54 percent White, 35 percent Hispanic, and 7 percent Asian with smaller percentages of African American and multiracial students
  - Around 20 percent of students qualify for free or reduced price lunch
- The school offers a wide range of support services including gifted education, English language learner programs, reading and math tutoring, counseling, and speech and language therapy

#### **2. Academic Standing and Programs**

- Math proficiency is around 85 percent and reading proficiency is approximately 80 percent
- The school provides enrichment through STEM projects, gifted instruction, academic competitions, and arts integration
- Data based instruction and small group interventions support student achievement

#### **3. Facilities and Learning Environment**

Palmetto Elementary is situated on a clean and well maintained campus featuring updated

classrooms, a science lab, outdoor learning spaces, and a secure main entry. The school emphasizes organization and safety during arrival and dismissal

#### **4. Values and Policy Environment**

District policies include recognition of gender identity and sexual orientation as protected categories. Teachers are expected to honor student selected names and pronouns beginning in PreK. No opt out is offered to parents. While there is no formal LGBTQ curriculum in early grades inclusive language may be used in counseling and classroom discussions when relevant

#### **5. Bathroom Policy and Privacy**

Restrooms are separated by gender and monitored by staff to ensure safety and privacy. There are no shared or gender neutral student restrooms. The school adheres to standard restroom policies consistent with traditional expectations

#### **6. Recent Issues of Note**

There are no recent reports of major safety incidents or chronic absenteeism concerns. The school has maintained strong attendance and consistent academic performance

#### **7. Religious Practices**

No issues have been reported related to religious expression. Students are permitted to pray or engage in religious reflection during non instructional times. The school does not interfere with individual religious practices when conducted respectfully

#### **8. Parent Engagement and Communication**

Palmetto Elementary has a highly active parent community. Families participate in PTA activities, classroom volunteering, and academic nights. Communication is regular and includes newsletters, online portals, and teacher updates. Staff are known for being accessible and responsive

#### **9. Parent Concerns and Suggested Actions**

Families with traditional or religious values may wish to consider:

- How gender identity policies are implemented in early grades
- The role of inclusive language in guidance or support services
- The level of transparency in school wide communication

Recommended next steps for parents:

- Tour the school and speak directly with leadership about classroom expectations
- Attend curriculum nights and parent events to observe school culture
- Review the parent handbook and district policy summaries
- Engage with the PTA to remain informed and involved
