Pinecrest Elementary School serves students from PreK through Fifth Grade in Pinecrest, Florida. It enrolls approximately 980 students, with a student teacher ratio of about seventeen to one. Academic performance is strong, with around 81 percent proficiency in math and 78 percent in reading. From a traditional or faith based perspective, the school receives a rating of 6.5 out of 10, reflecting high academic outcomes and positive parent engagement, with district-level policies on gender identity that may not align with all families.

1. Student Demographics and Support Services

- The student body is approximately 62 percent Hispanic, 25 percent White, 6 percent Asian, 4 percent African American, and 3 percent multiracial
- Around 23 percent of students qualify for free or reduced price lunch
 Support services include gifted education, special education, English language learner assistance, reading and math intervention, speech therapy, and counseling

2. Academic Standing and Programs

- Math proficiency is approximately 81 percent; reading proficiency is about 78 percent
- The school offers enrichment programs in science, music, and technology, alongside differentiated instruction and advanced curriculum for gifted students
- After school programs and clubs enhance student learning and social development

3. Facilities and Learning Environment

The campus features modern classrooms, a library, computer labs, and well-maintained outdoor

areas. Arrival and dismissal are organized with staff supervision. Events such as open houses, performances, and academic fairs support family involvement

4. Values and Policy Environment

The district requires schools to recognize student-selected names and pronouns from PreK, with no parental opt out. While no formal LGBTQ curriculum exists in early grades, inclusive language may appear in general communications or support services. Families who value a traditional learning environment may want to inquire further about how these policies are applied at the school level

5. Bathroom Policy and Privacy

Bathrooms are separated by gender. Hallways and shared spaces are supervised by staff. There are no shared unisex restrooms. Parents concerned about privacy may visit the campus and request clarification from administration

6. Recent Issues of Note

No major safety or misconduct issues have been reported. Absenteeism is not flagged as a concern in recent reports. The school maintains a reputation for academic excellence and community participation

7. Religious Practices

There are no reported conflicts with student religious expression. Personal prayer and religious identity are allowed during non instructional times. No practices or ideologies in opposition to religious values have been documented

8. Parent Engagement and Communication

The school has active parent involvement through PTA, school events, and classroom volunteering. Communication includes newsletters, emails, and updates via school platforms. Most parents report positive relationships with teachers and administrators

9. Parent Concerns and Suggested Actions

Families with traditional or faith based values may wish to consider:

- How gender identity policies are implemented in everyday school life
- Academic opportunities for enrichment or support depending on student needs
- The degree of transparency in communication from staff
- Family participation options and input into school activities

Recommended next steps for parents:

- Schedule a visit and meet with school leaders early in the year
- Ask for a parent handbook and clarify policies related to identity and communication
- Monitor student progress and seek academic support if needed
- Join school events to assess classroom culture and values alignment
