



## **Community Report on Redland Elementary School**

***A Traditional Parent's Perspective on School Policies and Environment***

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**Redland Elementary School** serves students from PreK through Fifth Grade in Homestead, Florida. The school enrolls approximately 640 students with a student teacher ratio of about fifteen to one. Academic performance is moderately strong, with around 58 percent proficiency in math and 52 percent in reading. From a traditional or faith-based perspective, the school receives a rating of **5.5 out of 10**, reflecting average academic outcomes, a calm school environment, and a district policy framework that some families may wish to evaluate closely.

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### **1. Student Demographics and Support Services**

- The student population is approximately 88 percent Hispanic, 9 percent African American, and 3 percent multiracial or other
  - About 90 percent of students qualify for free or reduced price lunch
- Support services include Title I programs, gifted education, reading and math intervention, English language support, special education, and counseling

### **2. Academic Standing and Programs**

- Math proficiency is approximately 58 percent, with reading proficiency near 52 percent
- Academic programs include STEM activities, i-Ready diagnostics, small-group instruction, and enrichment for high-performing students
- Bilingual instruction and after-school tutoring are provided for eligible students

### **3. Facilities and Learning Environment**

The campus includes traditional classrooms, a media center, science labs, and shaded outdoor

areas. Security protocols are in place during arrival and dismissal. The school promotes kindness and academic achievement through bulletin boards and student-of-the-month awards

#### **4. Values and Policy Environment**

Miami Dade County policy requires staff to recognize students by their chosen pronouns and names starting in PreK, without offering an opt-out for parents. No structured LGBTQ curriculum is implemented in early grades, but inclusive terms may appear in classroom discussions, guidance sessions, or posted material. Parents who prioritize traditional values may want to inquire how these policies are interpreted in school life

#### **5. Bathroom Policy and Privacy**

Restrooms are separated by gender, with no indication of gender-neutral or mixed-use restrooms. Staff supervision is in place in shared spaces such as hallways. Parents are encouraged to tour the school if they have privacy concerns

#### **6. Recent Issues of Note**

There are no major disciplinary or safety incidents publicly reported in the last two years. Attendance data has not been made public, and the school maintains a reputation for general calm and order. Some parents express concern over limited communication about behavioral updates

#### **7. Religious Practices**

No reports suggest opposition to religious expression at Redland Elementary. Students may engage in silent prayer or wear religious attire. There is no indication of anti-religious content or restrictions on personal faith during non-instructional time

#### **8. Parent Engagement and Communication**

The school encourages parent involvement through literacy nights, parent workshops, advisory committees, and bilingual newsletters. Some families report timely responses from staff, while others note challenges with reaching teachers or receiving behavior reports

#### **9. Parent Concerns and Suggested Actions**

Families with traditional or faith-based values may wish to consider:

- How identity policies are handled in student services and classroom interactions
- Availability of academic support and bilingual resources
- The degree of openness and responsiveness from school staff
- Whether school policies align with family preferences

#### **Recommended next steps for parents:**

- Schedule a visit with administrators to review current curriculum and support programs
- Attend school events and monitor classroom assignments
- Ask for regular updates on academic progress and behavioral incidents
- Request the family handbook for policies on identity, privacy, and communication
